Abstract

The biography of Gabriel Sales Pimenta, natural of Juiz de Fora, Minas Gerais, murdered at the age of 27 in Marabá, Pará, it's the first of the lawyers murdered on the violent dispute for rural property in the Amazon border. Militant of the "Movimento Revolucionário Oito de Outubro", the MR-8, it is notable for the defense of the landless families, that have occupied properties unproductive and the institutional support to the foundation of corporative foundations on the southeast of Pará, where he was engaged on a mission in the "Comissão Pastoral da Terra". This text expose from his schooling to the humanity influence of his family and religious friends, and policy militancy that got his trajectory reaped by his opponents from the countryside on a stage of development of the resistance in the region where the agricultural conflicts happens on a intense violence with no matchless in the Country. It get based in existent documentaries of the file from the "Comissão Pastoral da terra" of Marabá", in interviews with relatives and contemporaneous. It shows a rich trajectory of a left politic militant that got killed by land property representatives from southeast of Pará. It reveals the ineffectiveness of the justice and the impunity with the order and filing of the condemnation action against the responsibles for the murder of the lawyer.
