Title: The impact of structural and occupational mobility of young people in rural and mountainous regions of Cuba.

Rural studies regarding mobility and social stratification analyze the internal composition of the Cuban social structure with a look at the most urbanized regions, among other reasons because of the costs involved investigations in less urbanized and rural regions. In rural and mountainous areas there are impacts in this line that affects the most vulnerable age groups, in this case the young, so this paper proposes to analyze the impact caused by the structural and occupational mobility of young people in rural and mountainous regions of Cuba. This theme has a lack of scientific studies regarding the structural mobility in rural, mountainous regions specifically. Empirical research conducted for several years in the mountainous region allow to state that fluctuations are present in the occupational structure and influence the development of rural and mountainous areas, particularized also in sectors such as youth. Until then research on Cuba's agrarian structure are of interest in certain sociological groups with different approaches. The results of this study favor understanding the place of mobility studies in rural areas in Latin America and complete studies in Cuba generate new theoretical and practical knowledge of the subject, and new alternatives for decision makers.
