

CONCEPTIONS ABOUT THE PEASANTRY IN RURAL RESEARCH. A VIEW FROM THE SOCIOLOGY OF KNOWLEDGE IN CUBA

Rural studies in Cuba have a long history and extending in diverse scientific disciplines or branches of economic, social and political sciences. However, in the enlarged view of the countryside in Cuba includes some contributions about the peasantry, but are not reflected in the theoretical studies of the peasant as a group. For this reason the results of research presented contributes to the understanding of the sociology of knowledge production processes, taking into account the internal and external factors that are present Cuban context. This paper establishes an analytical model for understanding food producers subject: the sociology of knowledge, constitutes a theoretical-methodological approach is reinforced by applying techniques of content analysis and interviews.
