## **research profile**

I am currently directing the interdisciplinary research group on Critical Urban Studies and Social Theory at the Department of Political Science and International Relations at the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (Spain). Being additionally the scientific coordinator of the research, exchange and action network CONTESTED\_CITIES, my research has been focusing recently on three mutually interrelated topics:

- (i) Gentrification, displacement and social exclusion in the contemporary city
- (ii) Comparative approaches to crisis, financialisation and austerity urbanism
- (iii) Resistance to neo-liberal urbanism, with a focus on squatting and housing struggles

In the course of my research, I have been interweaving theoretical approaches rooted in critical anthropology, urban sociology, human geography and political science, constructing thus a radical perspective that bridges research in Europe and Latin America. Additionally, I have relevant experience with qualitative, participatory and visual methodology applied to urban studies.
